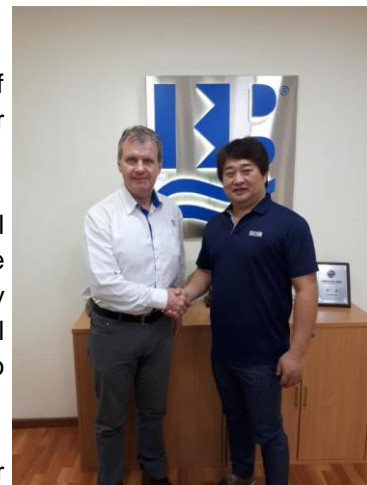

Various sharing sessions will also be arranged whereby Darren was invited as the keynote speaker to present on 'Safety Training and Competence' to a group of 250 delegates during the '**OSH Safety Seminar - Safety 360 degree**' held on the 15 October 2017.

5. KBA Europe: Scope of Services offered

- **Diving Technical Authority**

Our UK Entity has established a strong basis for the provision of Diving Technical Authority Services (DTA), Diving Client Representatives (DCR) and Audit / FMECA services in the UK, Europe and West Africa. With several clients using our DTA service for independent advice and support, our diving/ROV system auditing is becoming the benchmark standard for the region.

- **FMECA**

KBAE is making great headway in establishing an acceptable standard for their FMECA's. The standard seeks to cover all processes while indicating components covered. The indexing rational highlights what is considered high risk and independently indicates the residual risk. The take up has been excellent and this is encouraging the team to work harder on making the process actively live. Those clients that have sighted the document are immediately taken by the process and upon explanation of the process can quickly see that as a live document, it is designed to grow and take in failure modes noted over time or highlighted through future management of change.

- **Thermal Testing Equipment**

In a co-development with Singapore, KBAE has created a next generation of thermal testing equipment designed to increase our growing experience of testing hyperbaric life boats according to IMCA's D02/06 technical guidance note. It is our belief that we are now the most experienced independent testing facility for this process in the world. This upgrading of the equipment represents one of the multiple efforts that KBA as a group are heading with technology with many other initiatives in the pipeline.

With the recent completion of our new Thermal Balance and Environmental testing system, which is compact in size and provides real-time analytical testing and evaluation data, KBA has secured three hyperbaric environmental tests for SPHL and HRF's. The KBA environmental testing service is set to become the industry benchmark. Our second system is currently under construction and will be ready by end of Q1 enabling us to have testing systems in two hemispheres - North and South.

- **Inland/Inshore Works**

With the expertise gained within the offshore commercial diving sector, we have expanded into the inshore and inland markets to support Clients and Dive Contractors with safe and compliant diving operations and projects.

- **Partnership with Batok Offshore in Lagos, Nigeria for training and consultancy services**

We are now operational in West Africa with scheduled training courses and consultancy projects. Together with our partner - Batok Offshore and Oil Services Nigeria Limited, KBAE has successfully conducted the **Combined Diving System Assurance and FMECA Awareness**, and **Intensive FMECA** courses, to the Nigeria delegates in November 2017, which comprises a mix of operators and dive contractors. 2018 schedules will be released soon!

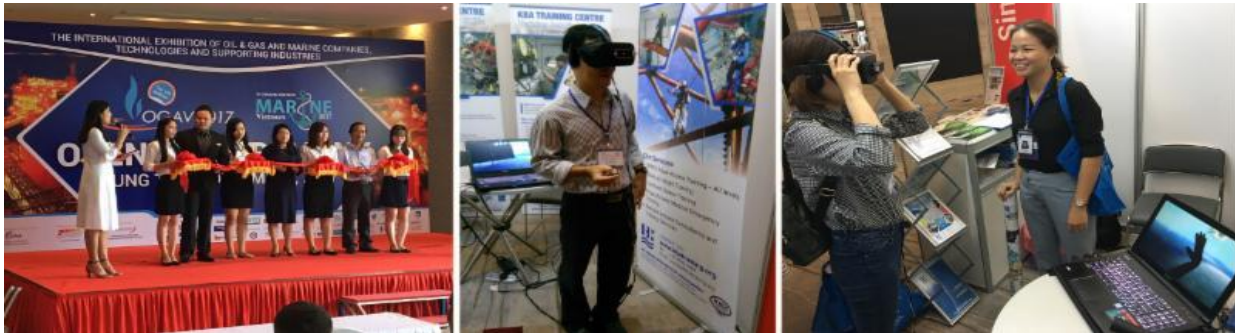

It is also envisaged that the event will bring sensible suggestions for future consideration by the IMCA Diving Division Management Committee.

This training will prepare the trainee supervisor to gain valuable panel hours prior to taking IMCA exam; whilst certified diving supervisors can refresh their skills, practice emergency drills on a class B simulator, as per IMCA D013 and IMCA D014, that cannot be scheduled to such detail and extent during offshore projects.

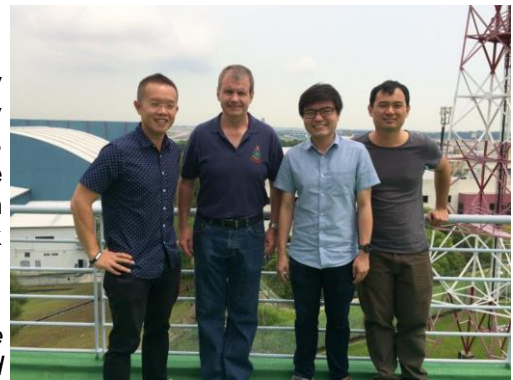

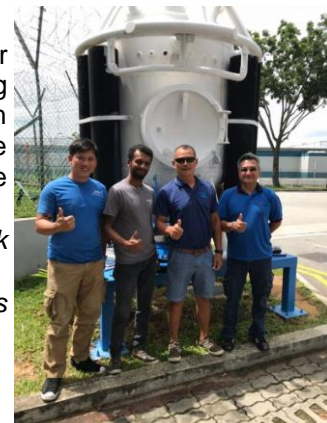


x. Inland/Inshore Surface Supplied Diving Equipment (SSDE) Diving Supervisor ~ 21 - 25 Nov in Singapore
